WHAT TO BRING

ATTENTION PARENTS

Please make sure to label EVERYTHING you send, and encourage your child to keep track of their items. We are not responsible for lost items, but there will be a Lost & Found on site.

CLOTHES

- o 8 Changes of Play Clothes (Camp is fun, and fun can be messy!)
- o 8 Pairs of Undergarments
- o 8 Pairs of Socks
- o Tennis Shoes (sturdy shoes for hiking, running, etc...extra pair of old shoes just in case it rains)
- o Sandals/Flip Flops
- o Long Pants & Sweatshirts (Can be chilly in the evenings)
- o Light-Weight Jacket (Preferably something that repels rain)
- o Modest Swimsuit (Required to swim)
- o T-shirt for Swimming (Dark in color. T-shirts must be worn while swimming)

ESSENTIALS

- o 3 towels (For Swimming and Showering)
- o Washcloth
- o Soap
- o Shampoo/Conditioner
- o Toothpaste & Toothbrush
- o Brush/Comb
- o Deodorant (If needed)
- o Pony Tail Holders/Baseball Cap
- o NIGHTTIME
- o Sleeping Bag and/or Blankets
- o Sheets (Twin size)

ODDS AND ENDS

- o Durable, Reusable Water bottle
- o Bug Spray
- o Sunscreen

QUIET TIME

- o Bible
- o Notebook
- o Pencils

OPTIONAL (BUT STRONGLY SUGGESTED)

- o Flashlight & Extra Batteries
- o Fans
- o Water Shoes
- o Disposable Camera
- o Pillow
- o 2 Sets of Pajamas

MEDICATIONS

Any medications sent to camp need to have detailed instructions printed on the bottle/package. If your child has multiple medications, please put them all in a large zip-loc bag labeled with your child's name and a phone number where you can most easily be reached.
